

**Town of Tyngsborough Highway Department

INVITATION FOR BIDS

Sealed bids for furnishing the following ITEM will be received at the Office of the Town Administrator, 25 Bryants Lane, Tyngsborough, MA, 01879, until the time specified below at which time the bids will be publicly opened and read:

In general, this contract consists of full depth reclamation, hot mix asphalt paving, installation of new bituminous berm, ADA/AAB conforming wheelchair ramps and driveway aprons, drainage improvements, signing, pavement markings and related work as directed by the Town Administrator, or his designee.

It is anticipated that the work to be done under this contract shall be completed within the 2016 construction season but a contract extension shall be at the discretion of the Town Administrator, or his designee.

Bids will be opened in the Office of the Town Administrator on Thursday, May 19, 2016, at 10:00 a.m. Town Hall, 25 Bryants Lane, Tyngsborough, MA, 01879. Each Bid must be accompanied by a bid security consisting of a BID BOND, CASH, or, CERTIFIED CHECK issued by a responsible bank or trust company in the amount of 5% of the bid price. All bidders must be pre-qualified by the Massachusetts Department of Transportation as follows. The MassDOT Prequalification Office will provide the Town with an official and a waiver contractor bid list for all contractors prequalified in the specified class of work within the parameters of this project. Only those bidders listed in the official or waiver contractor lists issued by the MassDOT Prequalification Office will be allowed to obtain an official proposal book.

All bids for this project are subject to applicable public bidding laws of Massachusetts, including G.L. c.30, § 39M, as amended. Attention is directed to the minimum wage rates to be paid as determined by the Town Administrator, or his designee of Labor and Workforce Development and the weekly payroll record submittal requirements under the provisions of Massachusetts General Laws, Chapter 149, Section 26 through 27D inclusive.
