The Town of Tyngsborough, Massachusetts Highway Department is seeking bids for the following listed road materials and services:

| Bituminous Concrete (at plant) | 500 Tons |
| Bituminous Concrete (in place) | 500 Tons* |
| Street Sweeping | 100 miles of road |
| Road Side Mowing | As needed |
| Catch Basin Cleaning | Approx. 1,460 |
| Line Painting (4" Yellow & 4" White) | Approx. 400,000 feet of each |

*As needed for small maintenance projects not associated with larger projects.

All bids must be accompanied by a bid deposit in the form of a bid bond, cash, certified check, treasurer's or cashier's check payable to the awarding authority in the amount of 5% of the value of the bid. If the responsiveness of a bid is not substantial and can be clarified, the Town may allow the bidder to make minor corrections, except to the Bid Prices.
