

Tyngsborough Sewer Commission
Comprehensive Wastewater Management Plan (CWMP)
Phase 1 West Needs Area

We are excited to announce that over the past several months, the Town of Tyngsborough through its Sewer Commission has been planning and designing a potential sewer construction project in the area of Flints Pond, the Town Center, Middlesex Road south of the Town Center, and Westford Road. This area was identified as the highest priority “needs area” for sewer in the Town’s 2009 state-approved Comprehensive Wastewater Management Plan (CWMP).

The Town has been approved for a low-interest State Revolving Fund (SRF) loan through the Massachusetts Water Pollution Abatement Trust (WPAT) to cover the capital costs of the project payable over a 20-year period. The Sewer Commission intends to bring construction of this project forward at the May 20, 2014 Annual Town Meeting for potential betterment bylaw and funding authorization, which would result in property owners being assessed a betterment to pay for a portion of the project cost.

The Sewer Commission will hold a public meeting to present details of this proposed construction project to impacted property owners on Thursday May 8, 2014 at 6:00 pm at the Tyngsborough High School in the Auditorium, 36 Norris Road, Tyngsborough, MA 01879.
