

VOTER REGISTRATION

Who can register to vote in Tyngsborough?

You can register to vote in Tyngsborough if:

- you are a United States citizen
- you live in Tyngsborough
- you will be 18 on or before election day

How can I register to vote?

In Person: It can be done in person at a variety of locations, such as:

- the local election office in any city or town in the Commonwealth
- a special registration event anywhere within Massachusetts
- the Registry of Motor Vehicles when applying for or renewing your driver's license
- the Secretary of State's office

By Mail: Mail-in registration forms can be obtained by:

- contacting the Town Clerk's office during regular office hours to request a Mail-In Registration Form
- downloading a National Voter Registration form available at www.sec.state.ma.us
- calling 1-800-462-VOTE

Confirmation of your mail-in registration will be sent within two to three weeks advising you of your voting location. If you do not, please contact the Town Clerk to verify your voting status.

When must I re-register?

As long as you continue to reside in Tyngsborough and answer the annual town census, you will continue to be a registered voter. Failure to respond to the annual census will require that you produce a picture ID and complete an affidavit of continuous residence when you next vote. If you move within Tyngsborough and want to vote from your new address, you should notify the clerk's office with your new address. If you move out of Tyngsborough, you will need to register to vote in your new community using any of the methods listed above.

Are there registration deadlines?

Yes, in order to vote you must be registered 20 days before all primaries and elections and/or 10 days before a special town meeting.
