Town Meeting. The Annual Town Meeting and Special Town Meeting will be held on Tuesday, May 15, 2007. The Selectmen and Finance Committee have been reviewing departmental budget requests and warrant articles during the past several weeks. The various warrant articles that have been submitted include the following: protective clothing and breathing apparatus for firefighters, an update of the Open Space and Recreation Plan per state requirement, purchase of the Shurfine property with community preservation funds so that the Town can begin to develop a Town Center in accordance with the Master Plan and Economic Development Plan, Phase 2 roof replacement at the Early Childhood Center, School Superintendent search, School technology and security upgrades, and refurbishment of the Middle School kitchen.

Government Study Commission. The Selectmen are in the process of forming a Government Study Commission that will review and make recommendations on the structure of the town government. The task is expected to take approximately 18 months. If you are interested in serving on the Commission, please submit a letter and resume to the Selectmen's Office indicating your reasons for volunteering, experience, and years as a Tyngsborough resident. The Commission's mission statement and by-laws are available upon request.

Building Maintenance Projects. We are in the process of obtaining bids on the replacement of the roof at the Police Station and windows at the Sherburne House. Funding for both projects has been approved by Town Meeting.
