

**Board of Health Minutes**  
**August 14, 2006**

The meeting opened at 6:00 P.M. with the full Board present.

The minutes of the meeting of 6/5/06 were approved as amended.

The minutes of the meeting of 7/17/06 were approved as written.

**Allied Waste Services**

Our Recycling Consultant, Dawn Hammil noted that on her last trip out monitoring trash and recycling she noted that several items were being taken by Allied Waste without a bulky sticker. The sticker on the bulky was put on by our consultant reminding the resident that they had to purchase a bulky sticker in order to dispose of the item.

The Board asked to have Allied Waste on the agenda for the next meeting.

**Emergency Management**

Some of the Board members were not sure whether they would have time to take the Incident Command System (ICS-100) course being run by our office on October 16<sup>th</sup> & 17. They would like to know whether it is mandatory for them to do so. One has begun taking it on line and another has already certified.

**Flu Clinics**

Questions arose as to whether the office can bill HMO's for shots being given to residents under 65 years of age.

A letter will be sent to the schools requesting the number of employees who would be interested in receiving the flu shot. Non residents may have to pay a small fee.

Our Tobacco Co-ordinator will attend the next meeting to discuss amendments proposed by Ms. Ryan and suggestions from her on our regulations.

**Other Business:**

Dumpster regulation were approved as amended.

Acme Waste has appealed the decision made by the court on money owed they owe the Town. They have also filed suit against the town on money they think we owe them.

Selectmen Lemoine came into our meeting to inform the Board that the Selectmen were very interested in purchasing the Tyngsborough Campground and would be using CPC money to do so. They have already made an offer and submitted a purchase and sales document to Attorney Zaroulis for his review. They also plan to do a Phase I 22E study if Mr Tocci accepts the offer. The Town is also looking at an adjoining piece of property that is for sale to be used as a second egress to the property.
