

**Board of Health Minutes**  
**March 12, 2007**

The meeting opened at 6:00 P.M. all members present.

The minutes of the meeting of February 12<sup>th</sup> were approved as written.

**Household Hazardous Waste Collection Day**

HHW is scheduled for May 19<sup>th</sup>. Board agreed to charge \$5.00 each for propane tanks.

**Rabies Clinic**

The clinic is scheduled for March 31<sup>st</sup>. Tires @ \$1.00 each and syringes and needles will be collected at no charge.

**Pondview II**

The Board reviewed several letters back and forth from Pondview II, BOH and Town Counsel, Zaroulis as well as a letter from DEP in response to our inquiry about power washing the system. DEP stated that the Board of Health had given above and beyond additional time due to the promise from Pondview II owners that they were going to do several things to the system in order to keep it going until the municipal sewer line became available. Since they have done very little that we have asked them to do and there is no concrete evidence of a sewer line becoming available, DEP recommended that we should now require them to replace the system.

The Board asked Mr. Watterman to put together a letter with recommendations for the next meeting and they will take it under advisement and make a decision at the next meeting.

**Office Clerk Position**

The final candidate, Lisa Laurencio came in to meet the Board of Health Members. The Board thanked her for coming in and offered her the position at the pay rate of \$11.91 per hour for 14 hours per week. Ms. Laurencio accepted the position.

**Old Town Hall**

Mr. Rizzo of Court Street Architects, Inc. came before the Board to discuss the remodeling of the old town hall. The proposal was possibly to make the whole upstairs a function hall that could hold up to 300 people. He realized that the existing septic system was not designed to accommodate 300 people but part of the money figures for remodeling included a new septic system.

Our engineer, Matt Watterman recommended a feasibility study to be done for the location of the new system since the Town owns the property next door as well.

### **64 Danforth Road**

A request for the potential owners of the above requested a temporary occupancy permit. They had to move by April 1<sup>st</sup> and requested to the Board that they grant it until the septic system issues were corrected. Mr. Waterman is not sure whether the system was installed in the wrong area or the topography lines are wrong. The engineer on the project is working on the issue.

The Board considered the request and denied it.

### **Irene Congdon/DEP Recycling Representative**

Ms. Congdon made very educational video presentation to the Board on Zero Waste.

All present, the Board, members of the recycling committee and Ms. Congdon all agreed that they do not know why our recycling amounts have not increased significantly since so many more residents are now recycling.
