The existing system is failing. In order to replace the system, two variances from the Board are needed

1. 310 CMR 15.405 (1)(g) Offset to well 100 feet to 83 feet – 17 foot variance request.
2. 310 CMR 15.405 (1)(i) To allow the use of a particle size analysis to determine an application rate instead of the requisite percolation test.

The Board approved the request for item #2. Number 1 was approved subject to an acceptable water test on the subject's well.

Wine Society -18C Pondview Place – Pondview II

Our food inspector, Bob Bracey was present.

Mr. Saunders returned to the Board to inform them that he has decided at this time not to pursue getting a full kitchen approved for use at his establishment. His intent was to serve food such as meat products to wine taster class members and teach them what type of wine would be served with that particular food. Since the present establishment he is renting is not set up to put in a full kitchen he has decided to just serve appetizers until he can find an establishment of his own. He will be installing a dishwasher to wash glasses and a small refrigerator.

Mr. Bracey told Mr. Saunders that he must keep his employee break room and the area where appetizers are being stored and prepared separate. Mr. Saunders agreed. The Board approved serving bread, cheese, crackers, fruit and prepacked products. The Board also approved the purchase of food from Bella Italia but reminded Mr. Saunders that it must be kept warm until served and can only be kept for 4 hours. Mr. Saunders agreed and thanked the Board for their time.

Other Business:

The next meeting is scheduled for October 15, 2007

The recycling committee will pursue options on how to enforce the recycling bylaw with business establishments in Town.

The minutes of the meeting of 8/13/07 were approved as written.

The Board agreed not to hold a Health Fair this year but will explore the possibility of hold one during the Pig and Apple Fest in October 2008.
