

**Board of Health Minutes**  
**April 14, 2008**

The meeting opened at 6:00 P.M. with Ms. Devanney, Ms. Meehan, Ms. Ryan, Ms. Perrault and Ms. Day present.

**Trash & Recycling Bid**

Ms. Ferrari reviewed the highlights of the new trash and recycling contract beginning July 1, 2008 with the Board such as:

Terms  
Carts  
Old Barrels  
Rebates for Paper  
Single Stream Recycling  
Tipping Fee  
Fuel Costs.

Ms. Perrault asked if I had the percentage amount that each Town's contract increased over the previous contract? I did not have the answer but said that I would try to get that information. I told the Board that I did not think I could get an amount since each Town's specifications were different but I would try. The Board also supported a 3 year contract with two 1 year renewals instead of a straight 5 year contract. They also wanted to know why the price for recycling took such a large jump over the present contract and lastly they would like Allied to check all the dumpsters being used for structural damage and cleanliness and replace them if needed and at least wash them all before the new contract takes effect.

**Other Business:**

The Board approved an hourly increase for out trash and recycling monitor. The new rate will be \$15.00 per hour for 100 hours. That rate includes gas mileage.

Ms. Day will put together a letter that will be sent out to all non-recyclers in Town urging them to please begin recycling.

The Board approved giving two recycling containers to Cannongate and Bridgeview Condo's. Both sites are using damaged containers at this time.

**Skate III**

Ms. Ferrari reported to the Board that Skate III did not do their monthly testing for grease content as requested by the Board back in June 2007. This request was part of the approval process for a new septic system to be installed for the building. The Board asked for a copy of the minutes of that meeting before making any further decisions.
