1. Executive Session (If Necessary)

A. Litigation Strategy/Verizon

Attorney Bill Solomon was present to update the Board on the Verizon cable license. He has prepared a license for the Board to review. The Attorney reviewed the document with the Board and answered questions. At the end of the session Attorney Solomon was to make corrections discussed this evening and will attempt to send the corrected document on Tuesday for the Board's review.

Motion by Selectman Booth to approve this document as corrected, second by Selectwoman Puleo.

Vote – Unanimous

2. Work Session - Budgets

The Board was asked by the Police Chief to sign a waiver for the two new patrolmen to start work without having attended the Police Academy. There are no classes available at this time. The two patrolmen will attend as soon as classes reconvene.

Motion by Selectwoman Puleo, to allow the Chief to appoint the two new patrolmen when the waiver is given, second by Selectman Booth.

Vote – Unanimous

The Board received a letter from the owners of the Tyngsboro Sports Center requesting a time to come before the Board to discuss having an all night party. The Girl Scouts have asked to do an all night. The Board wants to have the principals of Tyngsboro Sports Center at a hearing to discuss.

Mass Highway has sent a letter stating that they cannot accommodate a water line across the existing bridge. They have stopped the design process until they receive a letter from the Board that it is okay to continue without the water line. The Board will send a letter asking that if the water line cannot be extended on the existing bridge can they add the water line to the new bridge.

Selectman O'Connor has left the meeting. He has a conflict on the next topic for discussion.

The Board reviewed and voted to support Article 3 asking for a certification stipend for the Assistant Assessor.

Motion by Selectwoman Puleo to support the article as written, second by Selectman Booth.

Vote – 4 in favor, 0 abstain, 0 opposed. The motion does carry.

The Board will meet on Monday the 20th at 6 P.M. to discuss budgets.

The Board had a very short discussion on the budget as the hour was late. They had reviewed some numbers to give to the Chairperson to discuss with the Chairperson of the School Committee.

3. Adjournment

Motion by Selectwoman Puleo to adjourn, second by Selectman Booth.

Vote – 4 in favor, 0 abstain, 0 opposed. The motion does pass.

The meeting was adjourned at 9:40 P.M.
