Meeting Minutes
May 13, 2010**

Superintendent Update –

- There is a problem with the Chelmsford billing. Our flow checks do not align with Chelmsford's. We have had this problem in the past. Allen will work with Kerry to reconcile the account.
- The garage on Middlesex Ave. is available. It has twice the space for \$1,500 per month. Allen has investigated the lease agreements. Right now it will be a tenant at will agreement. An inspection of the Progress Ave. space will take place shortly. The Middlesex garage needs a new door. The move can be handled in-house.
- Received a call from a selectmen about a sewer backup at 43 Willowdale Ave. Paul checked it out. The occupant was not the owner and there was no back up.
- Received an emergency call from the Tyngsborough Police about 22 Westford Road. It was a failed septic system at Comets.
- Numerous odor complaints on Middlesex Road near Tyngsborough Family Dental. Someone was spraying pig and cow waste. Allen took a sample and alerted the Board of Health.
