

SPECIAL TOWN MEETING MINUTES February 15, 2012

Article 9. To see if the Town will vote to amend the Prudential (or General) Bylaws of the Town of Tyngsborough by adding at the end thereto the following: Article XLV: Agricultural Commission A Tyngsborough Agricultural Commission is hereby established. The Commission shall encourage the pursuit of agriculture in the Town of Tyngsborough, promote agriculture-based economic opportunities, facilitate the preservation of agricultural land, and act as facilitators, advocates, educators, and negotiators on agriculture-related issues. The Commission will consist of five members appointed by the Board of Selectmen for three year terms, with two initial appointments to be for three years, two initial appointments to be for two years, and one initial appointment to be for one year in order to have staggered terms. The Board of Selectmen may also appoint up to five alternate members, and shall appoint persons to fill vacancies, or take any other action relative thereto.
