Vote by Mail

Early Voting by mail will be available for all 2020 elections.

Last day to register to vote and change party enrollment for the State Primary:

Saturday, October 24, 2020

Last day to apply for an Absentee or Early Vote Ballot **BY MAIL** before the State Primary:

Wednesday, October 28, 2020 – 5 PM

Last Day to apply **IN PERSON** for an Absentee or Early Vote Ballot before the State Primary:

Monday, November 2, 2020 – 12 PM

In-Person Early Voting

Town Hall ~ 25 Bryants Lane

In Person Early Voting prior to Presidential Election:

Saturday, October 17th – Friday October 30th

Hours:

Saturday, October 17 Noon to 4 PM, Sunday, October 18, 10 AM to 2 PM

Monday, October 19 – Thursday, October 22, 8:30 to 4 PM, Friday, October 23, 8:30 AM to 12:30 PM

Saturday, October 24, Noon to 4 PM, Sunday, October 25, 10 AM to 2 PM

Monday, October 26 – Thursday, October 29 8:30 to 4 PM, Friday, October 30, 8:30 to 12:30 PM

Vote at your Polling Location on Election Day – Tuesday, November 3, 2020

Hours from 7:00 A.M. to 8:00 P.M.
